Use the Catalog Search box to search by keyword or phrase. Choose the Advanced Search link for additional search options.

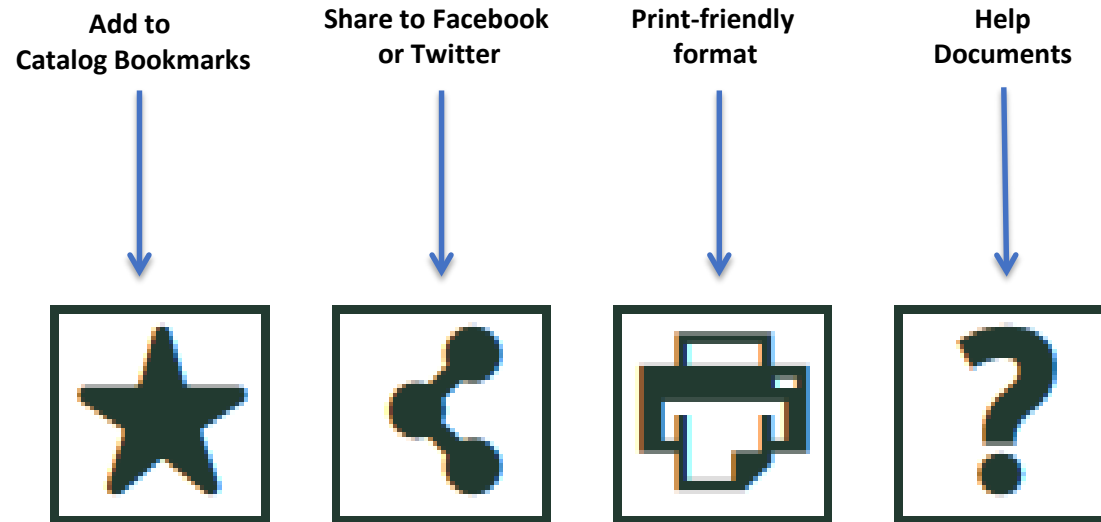






# Course Search
